A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR. \$200 Reward.

STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA, EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT. WHEREAS, official information has been received at this department that some person or persons unknown did on the 14th day of June, 1903, burn the mill of Mr. Wesley Thompson, in Robeson County;

AND WHEREAS, it appears that the said unknown person or persons have fled the State, or so conceal himself or themselves that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon him or them.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Charles B.
