Governor Glenn has written the following letter to Senators Simmons and Overman:

There, however.existsa very grievous wrong in regard to the shipping of spiritous liquors from other States into our State, and especially into the territory where the sale of liquor has been prohibited.

"I notiice in the papers that Senator Tillman, of South Caroline, and Senator Clay, of Georgia, are making an active fight for the passage of a law that will prohibit liquor dealers in one State shipping into prohibition territory in other States.

"This law is fair and just and should be enacted for the protection of the people who by their votes eliminated wishey traffic "I therefore, knowing the conditions which exist in the State, do earnestly beg of you to use your influence in enacting a law to prevent in the future shippers of whiskey in another State . from shipping to prohibition sections.
