GOOD ROADS.

Never before has there been such agitation for good roads. No one questions their value, the immense advantages to be derived from them, but the people of some sections are slow to take the steps necessary to build them.

Something in the way of building good roads is being done in Robeson. The Fayetteville road for several miles out from Lumberton, for instance, has been put in first-class condition.

The beauty about it is that good roads could be built for less than the present road tax. The road tax is now 20 cents on the \$100. It takes just 4 cents on the \$100 in Robeson to provide interest and sinking fund for 20-year bonds in the sum of \$100,000.
