Gathering at Duart Castle, Isle of Mull, Saturday, 24th August, 1912.

Many readers of The Robesonian will be interested in the following notice, a copy of which has been received by Mr. A. W. McLean of Lumberton (Miss Essie McLean, who spent several months with Mr. and Mrs. McLean here about a year ago, is a daughter of the undersigned John MacLean, at whose home Mr. and Mrs. A. W. McLean visited in Scotland some two or three years ago):

Glasgow, March 12, 1912

DEAR CLANSMAN (or Clanswoman),

The Chief of the Clan, Colonel Sir Fitzroy Donald MacLean, Bart., K. C. B., D. L., extends an invitation to his Clan to meet him at Duart Castle on Saturday, 24th August, 1912.

Upon this occasion the Chief will unfurl his banner on the ancient Stronghold of the MacLeans of Duart.

Duart Castle, which has recently come into the Chief's possession, after being out of the family for over two hundred years, was built in the 13th Century; it was repaired and enlarged by Hector Mor, Lord of Duart from 1523 to 1568. Sir John MacLean, Bart., who died in 1716, was the last Chief who lived at Duart; he was compelled to surrender the Castle in 1691. Our present Chief entered upon the work of restoration and repair of the Castle but the accomplishment of this will take some considerable time.

The undersigned committee were appointed at a Meeting of the Executive of the Clan MacLean Association and other Clansmen who were in Glasgow for the Clan Gathering in October last, and are making arrangements as to Fares, &c., to Oban and Duart. **Amalgamation of Greensboro Life and Jefferson Standard Insurance Companies.**

Terms for the amalgamation of the Greensboro Life Insurance Co. of this city and the Jefferson Standard Life Insurance Co. of Raleigh have been reached by stockholders of the two companies, and it is learned this afternoon that tentative arrangements for the consolidation have been worked out. No details of the merger were made public and it is said that the location of home offices, name, officials, etc., is yet to be determined. The consolidation of the two companies means a total capital stock of \$400,000, with an insurance in force of \$23,000,000, the largest it is said of any other Southern company. Officers declare that the consolidation will mean that the new company will be the largest in point of policies and insurance in force in the South. It is said that fully six weeks will be required in perfecting the merger.
