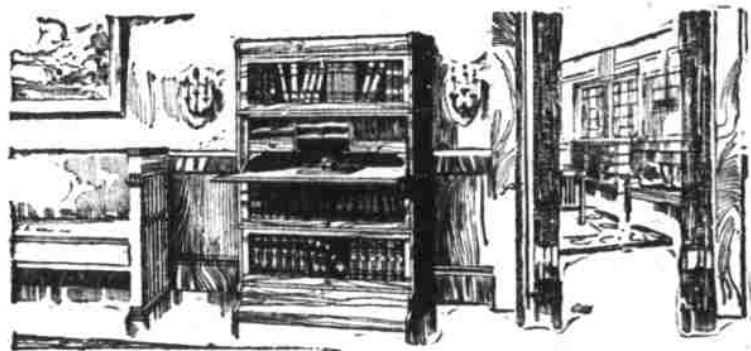

Gov. Craig Appoints Men to Represent North Carolina at Panama Exposition.

Raleigh News and Observer. North Carolina's official commission, which is to represent the State at the Panama-Pacific exposition in San Francisco next year, was appointed yesterday by Governor Craig. The members are General Julian S. Carr, of Durham; Stuart W. Cramer, of Charlotte; C. E. Hutchinson, of Charlotte; John C. Drewry, of Raleigh; Hugh McRae of Wilmington; C. A. Holderness, of Tarboro; and T. D. Brown, of Salisbury, and J. A. V. Lindley of Greensboro.

The question of providing money for the State's representation was raised at the 1913 General Assembly but it was not acted upon. Governor Craig has named a list of men who have means and will bear their expenses to the exposition, but there has been no appropriation for the State's show at the exposition. Free space is given and two thirds of the States have made reservations in which to make their exhibits.

Speaking of the coming exposition, Governor Craig said today:

"The exposition at San Francisco celebrates the opening of the Panama Canal. This is an event significant in the destiny of the South. North Carolina should not lose this opportunity to exhibit to the people of the world her resources and possibilities. It is the beginning of an era of development, and North Carolina ought to reap her share of the benefits. Virginia has contributed \$40,000, Tennessee has raised \$37,000. Arkansas \$75,000. Other Southern States will probably provide for exhibition in the near future.

Progressive Party of State Wants Roosevelt for 1916—Pass Resolutions.

The executive committee of the Progressive party met in Greensboro Friday and authorized Chairman Z. V. Walsler and National Committeeman Williamson to fix the time and call the State convention, also adopted resolutions and ordered a cablegram to ex-President Roosevelt which cablegram was as follows:

"We hereby extend our cordial greetings and believe existing conditions demand your nomination and election as President of the United States in 1916."

The following resolutions were adopted:

"1. We hereby reaffirm our allegiance to and faith in the Progressive State and National platform.

"2. We oppose any entangling alliances with any other political party or parties.

"3. We hereby extend a cordial invitation to the Progressive orders of all existing parties to join us.

"4. There is little hope of relief from the old parties, bossed and controlled as they are and have heretofore been.

"5. We view with alarm and heartily condemn the action of President Wilson in demanding at the hands of Congress the repeal of the former act of Congress exempting coastwise shipping from the payment of Panama Canal tolls, in spite of the fact that canal tolls exemption was demanded in the National platform of the Progressive, Democratic and Republican parties in 1912."
