(Below we are publishing a part of the primary bill which was drawn up by Chairman T. A. McNeill and submitted to the county Democratic Ex. ecutive Committee at its meeting on the 15th inst. and which was approved by the committee. Candidates for the Legislature will be asked to pledge themselves to have such measure passed for Robeson county if elected. This is the conclusion of the proposed law, parts of which have been published in the Robesonian of July 20 and 23-Editor).
