### NEED PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING

Opinion of Miss Crandall, Noted Expert Touring South  
State Board of Health Bulletin.  
Miss Ella Phillips Crandall, secretary of the National Association of Public Nursing of New York City, in her address at the Yarrow House in Raleigh recently, made all North Carolinians, the citizens of Raleigh in particular, feel that they are yet far behind progressive health measures in that so few public health nurses are at work in the State. According to Miss Crandall and other health workers, the public health nurse is accomplishing more for individual and family health, better living conditions and practical education along all health lines than any other single agency now engaged in health or social uplift work.

### VILLA RAIDS UNITED STATES TERRITORY TROOPERS INVADE MEXICO

16 Americans killed at Columbus, N. M. and many buildings fired. Troopers of 13th U. S. Cavalry follow band into Mexico—Villa had 500 men—Score of invaders slain

Columbus, N. M., Dispatch, March 9. Francisco Villa, outlawed Mexican bandit, raided United States territory today. With 500 men he attacked Columbus, killed at least 16 Americans and fired many buildings before he was driven back across the international border.

Not less than 250 troopers of the 13th United States cavalry followed the Villa band into Mexico. Reports to Col. H. J. Stocum, commanding United States troops at this point, late today stated that Villa had made a stand 15 miles south of the border where spirited fighting ensued. In this engagement an unnamed private was killed and Capt. George Williams, adjutant of the 13th cavalry, was wounded.

The small detachment of troopers under Maj. Frank Tompkins and Elmer Linsley, fighting dismounted, made a determined stand against the renewed Villa attack, and at last reports were holding their ground.

The raid on American territory proved costly to the bandit chieftain. The bodies of 18 bandits, including Pablo Lopez, second in command, had been gathered and burned before noon and troopers reported an undetermined number of dead still lying in the brush. Led to the attack under the slogan: "Death to the Americans", Villa's followers fought with desperation. Just before dawn they crept along ditches skirting the United States cavalry camp and rushed the sleeping town, firing heavily.

The raid on American territory proved costly to the bandit chieftain. The bodies of 18 bandits, including Pablo Lopez, second in command, had been gathered and burned before noon and troopers reported an undetermined number of dead still lying in the brush. Led to the attack under the slogan: "Death to the Americans", Villa's followers fought with desperation. Just before dawn they crept along ditches skirting the United States cavalry camp and rushed the sleeping town, firing heavily.

Stores were looted, oil was poured upon frame structures, and the match applied by still other bandits. The postoffice was raided, furniture smashed, but the looters secured only one small registered package. Many civilians barricaded themselves in their homes and fired at the Mexicans as they darted through the streets. The fighting in the town ended almost as suddenly as it began. Less than two hours after the first shot was heard, Villa's banders sounded the retreat and the raiders began a disordered flight, closely followed by American troopers.

Mrs. Maud Hawk Wright, an American woman who said she was held captive by Villa for nine days and was liberated in the midst of today's fighting declared today that Villa announced on March 1 his intention to attack Columbus and proceeded north under forced marches to carry out his purpose.

His men, with scant supplies of water and meat suffered severely, she said, and many dropped from their horses on the march to Boes Grande. Villa, she declared, ruled them by fear and his officers with the flats of their swords beat the soldiers into submission sufficient to reach that point where they rested and prepare for the raid.

Yesterday Mrs. Wright related, Villa bandits attacked employees of the Palmetto Cattle Company, engaged in rounding up cattle, killing four Americans.

Mrs. Wright said her husband, Edward John Wright, formerly of Houston, Tex., and Frank Hayden, a youth employed at the LaBooker saw mill, were taken from the Wright ranch March 1 and presumably killed. When she was taken prisoner and forced to ride away with a detachment of Villa's men under Col. Nicholas Servantes, she said a bandit ordered her to give her baby to a Mexican family.
