ROBESON COUNTY MEN WHO WILL BE CALLED

Notices Will Be Mailed This Week For Men Registered For Army Service to Appear Before Local Boards for Examination—First Call Will Reach Only First 360 Names Drawn.

The master list sent out by the War Department showing the order of liability for military service of the 4042 Robeson county men who registered according to the army draft act, are now in the hands of the two exemption boards. The boards are busy preparing the notices which will be mailed to the 360, or approximately that number, in each of the two districts in the county advising them to appear before the board for examination.

It is thought that the boards will be ready to mail out the notices Wednesday of this week, August 1. While it has not been definitely determined, it is expected that those to be examined on the first call will be summoned to go before the boards August 6, 7 and 8—one third of the number to be examined to appear each of the three days. Those summoned will be advised what day to appear before the board. Those who have to appear before the board in district No. 1 will be examined in Lumberton. Each one to be examined must be in the court room at the court house here at 9 a. m. on the day he is to be examined. Those who belong to district No. 2 will be examined at Red Springs.

Mr. T. L. Johnson, chairman of the board in district No. 1, says the men will be examined in the manner they were drawn. The first man drawn will be examined first and so on down the list. A man must be in the court room when his name is called, as no time will be lost in looking men up when their names are called.

If the required number needed from this county is not secured from the men first called before the boards others will be called in the order in which they were drawn.

When the second call is made the list will be drawn where the first list stopped. Many are asking when will the second call be made. This is unknown. Some think it will be in about three months, but this is only guessing at the time.

Mr. Johnson asks The Robesonian to state that no one need apply for information from the board unless he gives his serial number; that is, the number by which his name was drawn in Washington. Many are also asking for exemption blanks, but these can not be given out until after a man has passed the physical examination. The blanks will be supplied after one has passed the examining board. Those who fail to pass the physical examination will be given a certificate showing that they failed before the local district board.

In the following lists are published the names of those who will be summoned to appear before the two boards of Robeson county. The first number is the order number, showing the order in which the second, or serial, number, was drawn.

A separate list is published for each district. This is necessary because district 1 has more names than district 2, hence the order numbers do not fit the same serial number in each district in every case. The first number drawn was 258, hence in each of these lists it appears 1-258. Reading with this explanation in mind there need be no difficulty in each person understanding the order in which his number was drawn.

Robeson county registrants whose names do not appear in either of the lists published in The Robesonian today are so far down the list of order numbers that there is no probability they will be reached in the first call. In subsequent issues additional lists will be published so that each registrant in the county may have a record of his order number and serial number by saving The Robesonian in which his name is published.
