REVIVAL SERMONS.
Sermons by Rev. Dr. McDaniel at
Meeting Which Closed at First
Baptist Church Last Week.

How a Christian May Know He is a
Christian.
"These things have I written unto
you that believe on the name of the
Son of God; that ye may know that
ye have eternal life, and that ye may
believe on the name of the Son of
God." 1st John 5th chapter and 13th
verse. Dr. McDaniel preached from
this text Wednesday evening.
Because God Says So.
Declaring that a Christian may
sometimes have doubts as to his con-
version, Dr. McDaniel told how a

Christian may know that he is a
Christian. First, he said that he may
know it because God says so. Be-
cause of his dependence and faith in
God. When you have repented and
believed, God is then responsible for
your salvation.

From His Own Conscience.
Second, a Christian may know that
he is a Christian from his own con-
science. Experience brings satisfac-
tion to the Christian. The preacher
asked, "What will convince the un-
believer that you are a Christian?" In
answering this Dr. McDaniel said,
the flight from sin, the putting off of
the old and putting on the new man,
hating things you once loved, by liv-
ing an upright life before men. Put
sin out and put on Christ and the
world will not doubt you. Sinners will
read you when they will not read the
Bible. You must furnish the fruit
that will satisfy the unsaved that you
are a Christian. If a sinner can see
in you the marks of religion he will
not doubt you. You can convince the
sinner by giving up sin and pursuing
righteousness.

Do you love Christ and do you love
lost souls? asked the preacher.

Be Faithful Unto Death.
"Be thou faithful unto death and I
will give thee a crown of life"—Revela-
tions 2:10—was the text from which
Dr. McDaniel preached Thursday
morning.

I give unto thee eternal life. The
free gift from the Lord is eternal life
through Jesus Christ. If you are
faithful unto death he will give you
the crown of life. Young people ought
to be put in activity in the churches.
When God appeared to Abraham to
lead his country he had faith in God
and the first step he went out as God
had commanded because he had the
faith and God had told him that he
would show him the way. He had the
faith to take the step of trust, faith
in the promise that God would show
him the way. He believed the prom-
ise of God even when contrary to the
laws of nature. God told him to take
his son and sacrifice him. He had the
faith to start to the task even though
it pained him very much. When God
saw that he had the faith and Abra-
ham was about to slay his son, the
Lord stopped him. Thus Abraham be-
comes the father of faith. We get
in line with Abraham if we get in the
faith of Abraham. According to
your faith, be it unto you.

Be thou faithful in the life of morals.
The devil could ruin every Chris-
tian in this town. Be faithful in the
life of worship. Daniel, knowing
there was an order against his sys-

a conviction that it was his duty. So
three times a day he turned his face
toward Jerusalem and prayed to God.
