President in his faithful execution of the most gigantic trust ever placed upon the heart and brain of a human being."

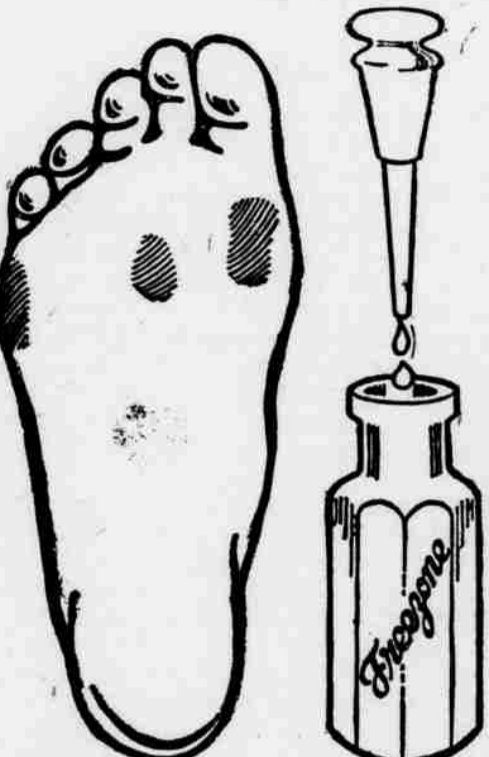

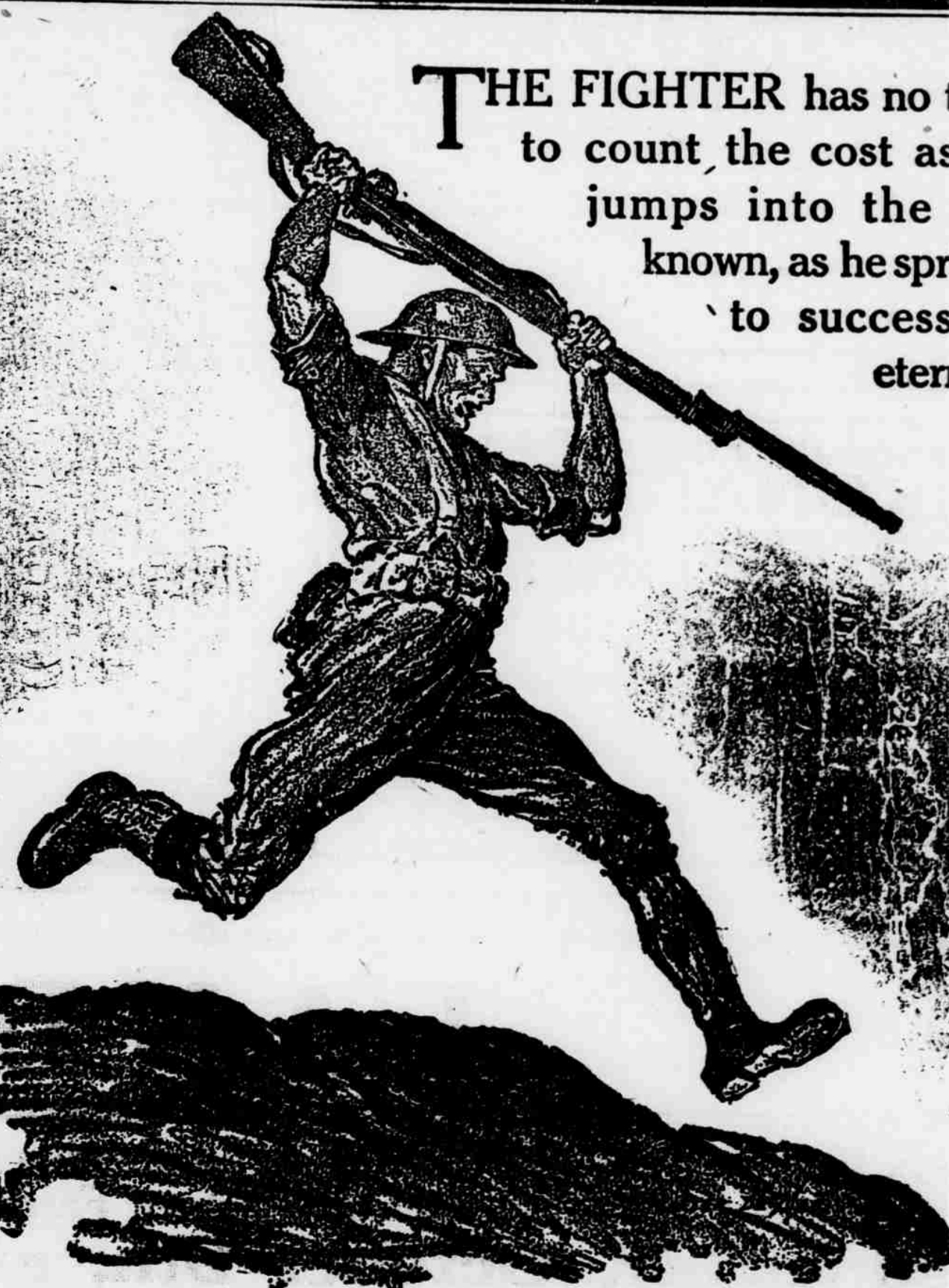
