DELIVERIES OF COAL LIMITED.

Cotton Mills and Other Manufacturing Plants May Have to Close Down—Coal Production Still Below Requirements.

Orders limiting deliveries of coal in the southern region of the railroad administration to the first five classes on the fuel priority list, which does not include manufacturers, were issued Monday at headquarters at Atlanta, Ga. The action on its face means the closing down of cotton mills, the manufacturing plants of almost all descriptions as soon as their present supplies are used up. These supplies generally are understood to be scanty.

Curtalement of coal consumption was made necessary, the statement said, because "coal production is still below the absolute requirements of the first five classes of consumers." These classes, who are still to get coal, are railroads, inland and coastwise vessels, army and navy and certain government department, state, municipal and county institutions, public utilities, including newspapers and retailers to supply domestic consumers.

No announcement was made as to whether the sharp curtailment of coal consumption would be nationwide, but it has been understood that about the same conditions prevail in other sections of the country. Reports generally have shown many miners not returning to work, despite cancellation of the strike call on order of the Federal court at Indianapolis.

McLEAN FOR SECRETARY OF THE TREASURY

Among those mentioned to succeed Carter Glass on his withdrawal from President Wilson's cabinet as secretary of the treasury, A. W. McLean of Lumberton is mentioned in Washington. Mr. McLean is now a member of the War Finance Corporation, and it is said that he has made an excellent record and stands well with the administration.

Mr. McLean, who is one of the leading lawyers of the Cape Fear section and a banker of prominence, has a strong following in North Carolina, and his appointment would be hailed with general approval in this part of the country. He is of the sturdy Scotch stock, who have a natural talent for finance and the handling of money, and whose patriotism has always been a bulwark to their government.

NEW COTTON MILL CHARTERED FOR ST. PAULS.

Ernauldson Cotton Mills company, of St. Pauls, Robeson county, with an authorized capital of \$300,000, and a subscribed capital of \$150,000 has been granted a charter by the secretary of State. The company is authorized to a general milling business. R. C. Lawrence of Lumberton, A. R. McEachern and W. D. Johnston are named as petitioners.
