



LAW OF THE U. STATES.

AN ACT to amend an act, entitled "An act to grant a quantity of land to the State of Illinois..."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the lands granted to the State of Illinois by the act to which this is an amendment...

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That at the further time of five years be allowed the State of Ohio to commence the Miami canal from Dayton to Lake Erie...

AN ACT to incorporate the Georgetown Free School and Orphan Asylum, in the District of Columbia.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That Stephen D. Boushon, Lewis Corbrey, Peter O'Donnoghue, Edward B. King, Enoch King, Charles K. Ignatius Clarke, Bernard Brien, A. H. Boucher, John R. May, and Joseph Brooks, and their successors in office, are hereby made, declared and constituted, a corporation and body politic, in law and in fact...

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That all and singular the lands, tenements, rents, legacies, annuities, rights, privileges, goods, and chattels, that may hereafter be given, granted, sold, devised, or bequeathed, to the Georgetown Free School and Orphan Asylum, be, and they are hereby, vested in, and confirmed to, the said corporation...

AN ACT to authorize the President of the United States to cause the public surveys to be connected with the line of demarcation between the States of Indiana and Illinois.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the President of the United States be, and hereby is, authorized and required to cause the public lands lying along the line of demarcation between the States of Indiana and Illinois...

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and hereby is, authorized to allow for the service to be performed under this act; such further compensation in addition to the regular price now authorized by law...

AN ACT further to extend the powers of the Board of Canal Commissioners for the improvement of the Tennessee river, in the State of Alabama.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the commissioners appointed by the State of Alabama to superintend the improvement of the Tennessee river, and their successors in office, be, and they are hereby authorized to suspend the improvement of so much of said river as is below Florence, in said State, and every other part of the same...

Sec. 4. And be it further enacted, That there shall be a meeting of the regular annual contributors to the support of the Georgetown Free School and Orphan Asylum...

School and Orphan Asylum, in the month of June, in each year, the hour and day and manner of giving notice for which to be regulated by the by-laws...

Sec. 5. And be it further enacted, That, with the consent and approbation of the parent, guardian, or friends, who may have the care of any male or female child, or where a child may be destitute of any friend or protector, the same may be received into the Georgetown Free School and Orphan Asylum...

Sec. 6. And be it further enacted, That any vacancy which, from death, resignation, or otherwise, may happen in the board of trustees, shall be filled according to the mode to be prescribed in the by-laws...
