

*To the Citizens of the Tenth Congressional District:*

FRIENDS—CITIZENS:—The term for which I was elected to represent you in Congress expired on the 3d instant. I have already announced to you that I am not a candidate for re-election, but before I take my leave of you, I feel it to be my duty to lay before you such information on the state of our affairs, as in my opinion may be interesting to you.

You well remember at the time I became a candidate, that the country was laboring under considerable pecuniary embarrassment; and that my opponent, and myself offered as to the cause of it. He charged the whole of it to mis-administration in the Government, while I, without justifying his charges, assigned other causes.

You will also recollect, during the last summer's campaign, we were everywhere told by the advocates of Gen'l. Harrison, that his election would restore confidence—raise the prices of produce—increase the gains of miners, and in short give us better times. He has now been elected nearly five months, and I leave it to you to say whether these promises ever been realized or not. I do not here mention these facts, for any other purpose than to show that some of you, very honestly, no doubt, were mistaken in the *causes* that produced the "hard times."

You were induced to believe that they were brought on by the acts of Mr. Van Buren's administration, and that the only remedy was, to turn them out, and put Gen'l. Harrison in. You will soon see whether this was a just conclusion or not. At the same time that I am free to say, I was a good deal more anxious of the acts of the two last administrations, particularly that of Gen'l. Polk, who so much overreached the measures referred to, and gave us the evils we complain of. I do not believe they were *the causes* of them. The cause lies deeper. I do not now intend to go into the history of it further than to observe,—that all the embarrassments we are laboring under at this time may be fairly traced to two causes,—that is, the *Banking system*—and the *Protective Tariff*—and to the "Banking system,"—Please bear me for a cause, and as they disappear so will the evils we complain of disappear.

In the first place, Admin-strations, measures were adopted to increase the value of the dollar. By the act of 1833, the high tariff was reduced to a rapid state of reduction, and on the 30th of June, 1842, it was reduced to 20 per cent ad valorem; and, it is to be observed, it was again in time of peace, submitted to pay a high rate of interest in the dollar.

The high rate of interest is now running out as fast as any prudent man can desire. The shadow should be more rapid, the shock on the market should be greater, and the suffering more severe.

Next, the high rates of things brought upon the country by these taxes, will be discontinued, and trade and commerce will be allowed to go on in their natural way, and to them, may we look for stability and tranquillity, as far as the *tariff* is concerned. That this will be done, is now certain, under the measures which are adopted, cannot be well disputed. It is also equally certain to the new Administration—and, whilst I do not know what they are, as yet, in its details, we do a great service to the *country*, by vindicating it that the leading friends of Gen'l. Harrison, and his supporters, at the South, marked out for him a course of action, which, in regard to the Southern States,—so much so, that they were to be sure to bring him into the party of some of the ablest Whigs in Congress. As such, the *Harrison*'s administration will fall into these ranks, and be seen.
