PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS.—There are two propositions before the Senate for a change in the method of choosing the President of the United States.

Mr. Sumner's plan proposes a radical change to an election by popular vote of the whole country, thus abolishing State lines so far as the National Executive is concerned, and abolishing the office of Vice-President altogether.
