Reports from Haywood, Tipton and Lauderdale counties, Tenn., and Mississippi and Crittendon counties, Ark., are to the effect that the frost of Friday and Saturday night killed all of the cotton in these counties, necessitating replanting and setting farmers back about two weeks.

The result of the important case now before the Supreme Court of the United States, wherein New York is plaintiff and Louisiana is defendant will be awaited with interest. One of the purposes of the New York law, allowing that State to bring suit against any State that refuses to pay her bonds owned by a citizen of New York, is to enable suits to be brought on North Carolina special tax bonds. We therefore have a direct and immediate interest in the decision of this case.

Packing the Jurors. We ask the people of the United States whose sense of justice is rarely if ever obscured, whether they approve of packing jurors to secure convictions, even when the offenses charged relate to elections and the defendants are white men and South Carolinians?

MEMORIAL. We invite the American people to remember the Elliott cases which were political in their nature. Chief Justice Waite, on the bench in the Circuit Court in this city, ruled that the government had not the right to "stand aside" jurors in the mode now allowed. Only the week before last, when Kane was on trial for murder, Judge Bond, who was on the bench with Chief Justice Waite, in the Elliott trials, ruled that the prosecutors could not reject jurors by standing them aside.

We protest against it in the name of liberty and justice. We protest against it in the name of outraged and insulted law. We protest against it as a double crime—a crime that begins by assuming that every one of the accused is guilty, and ends by forming a jury that is relied on to register obediently Mr. Melton's will. As far as ingenuity can compass it there will be no lack of convictions.
