POSTMASTER BOYDEN INSTITUTES AN INVESTIGATION RESULTING IN THE CAPTURE OF THE ROBBER.

Jethro Almond was arrested on last Monday at Albemarle, in Stanly county, and committed to jail, being accused of the systematic robbery of the U. S. mail between Salisbury and Albemarle.

The facts in the case are about as follows: for several months Postmaster Boyden had been convinced that the mail on this route was being tampered with, but he was unable to detect just where and how it was done.
