Section 21 of Article xiv of the Constitution of the State of North Carolina, reads as follows: "No person who shall hereafter fight a duel, or assist in the same as a second, or send, or accept, or knowingly carry a challenge therefor, or agree to go out of the State to fight a duel, shall hold any office in this State."

There are good men in this State who consider a member of the Legislature as "holding an office in the State," and therefore coming under the prohibition of the Constitution in respect to duelling, and are watching to see how this matter may be settled.
