Tobacco Flies.

SIMPLE METHOD FOR DESTROYING

An exchange offers the following advise in regard to destroying the troublesome tabacco fly. Cut this out and paste in your hat.
"To kill the tobacco fly use plenty

of cobalt dissolved in water and sweetened with sugar or honey. Drive stakes all around the tobacco patch fifty or sixty yards apart. Get strips of shingles or laths and bore holes in them. Nail these on top of the stakes and every evening about sundown go with a basket of jimson flowers and put one in each hole in each shingle, drawing it down tight enough to prevent the wind from blowing it out, and then put in three drops of cobalt, and be sure to commence this as soon as the first flies come. It will pay you to grow some early jimson plants in your hot bed or with your tomato plants, so as to have your jimson blossoms in time. Don't put any in the patch; all around the edge will be enough."




