In the Superior Court, on Thursday, Judge Long pronounced sentence on Jake Skuford and Louis Clement, the two negroes who were put on trial last week charged with burglary, which charge was not sustained, the jury finding them guilty of larceny. The court gave them three years each in the penitentiary. Their counsel at once gave notice of appeal on the ground that the punishment was excessive, and contrary to the statute which provides a maximum penalty of one year for petit larceny, where the amount involved is under \$20.
