California is the only State which makes a commercial production of borax annually. The output for 1910 according to the United States Geological Survey was 42,857 short tons, valued at \$1,801,842. Less than 4 tons was imported. About one half of the borax consumed is used in the enameling industry for making kitchen and sanitary ware. Each year some new use is found for the mineral.

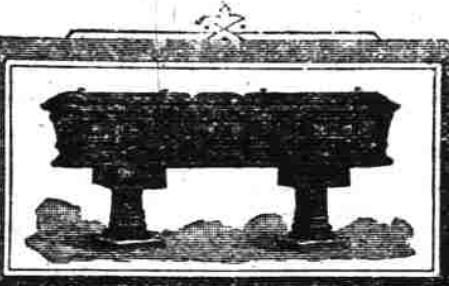
