#### Breat Crowd Seas Ford Party off.

New York, Dec. 4.—Henry Ford and more than 80 members of the Ford peace commission sailed from here today on the steamer Oscar Il, for Christiansand, Norway, for the purpose of creating sentiment for a conference of nentral Nations in the hope of ending the European war. The party was accompanied by 57 newspaper correspondents and photographers, and more than 20 general assistants, secretaries and stenograph

The steamers sailed at 3.15 clock p. m., one hour and 15 minutes later than the scheduled sailing hour. The delay was caused largely by the late arrival of 15 members of the Ford party, as well as the large crowd which thronged to ship to bid farewell to various members of the party.

William Je nings Bryan spent ome time on the ship, bidding Good speed," as he termed it, to the party. Thomas A. Edison was another of those called on Mr Ford after the latter had boarded the steamer.

"There is some chance for the mission to succeed," said Mr. Bryan, 'that is all I care to say now, except that I wish them every good fortune."

Just before the gang plank was pulled up a cable messenger rushed on the ship, and it was report-N. W. Morgan & Sons, have ed that Ford had received a message from King Haskon of Norway stating the F rd party would be courteously received in Norway.






