JAPAN AFTER FOOTHOLD AT CANAL.

Secretary Lansing Orders Investigation of Reports of 60,000 Acre Land Concession.

Washington, Aug. 21.-Investigation of reports from Panama that a 60 000 acre land concession at the Atlantic end of the canal is being sought by a Spaniard named Fernandez, presumably for Japanese interests, was order ed today by Secretary Lansing. Mr. Lansing refused to discuss the report in detail but the action was considered significant.

Rumers of a similar nature have been common ever since the canal was well under way. Several months ago it was commonly believed in diplomatic circles that private Japanese shipping interests were seeking land through Spanish intermediaries to establish a base for storing coal at lower rates than could be had from the American Government monopoly base. So far as known nothing definite came of that

The present reports are that Fernandez is seeking or has already secured a 60,000-acre land concession through the activity of Ramen Valez, whose recent election to the presidency of Panama may possibly be disputed by the United States because of alleged frauds and coercion.




