The board ascribed an upward trend to the law creating the Reconstruction Finance corporation, the organization of the corporation's work, and the enactment of the Glass-Steagall bill to increase the powers of the Federal Reserve system.

The aboard reported that bank suspensions in February numbered 115 and in January and February numbered 457. Those that failed in February had deposits of \$60,047,000, while those that closed in the two months had deposits of \$285,521,000. In February 32 banks with deposits of \$11,-835,000 reopened, while in the two months 51 banks with deposits of \$22,787,000 reopened.

President Hoover at his regular Friday press conference announced that a total of \$234,981,714 had been lent by the Reconstruction corporation.

Of this amount 587 banks and trust companies received \$126,895,073, or an average of \$216,162.

The second largest amount went to the secretary of agriculture for agricultural loans. A total of \$50,000,000 was turned over to him promptly after the corporation was organized. .

Thirteen railroads have received \$46,975,557 or an average of \$3,613,-

Building and loan associations totaling 10 received \$2,917,000 or an average of \$162,055.

Thirteen insurance companies received \$5,765,000, or an average of \$443,461.

Loans totaling \$775,000 have been made to two joint stock land banks, and \$1,362,000 has been lent to three mortgage toan companies.
