Brummitt Explains N. C. Election Laws

While the Australian ballot law specifically declares that "no markers shall be named or permitted in primary elections," there are three methods by which those desiring assistance in marking their ballots may receive it, Attorney-General Dennis G. Brummitt points out in a letter to Judge J. Crawford Biggs, chairman of the state board of elections.

The three methods by which voters may obtain assistance in marking their ballots are set forth by Mr. Brummitt as follows: 1. A voter may ask and secure aid from any election official at his voting precinct—that is, from either the registrar or from one of judges of election.
