

### Composite 1932 Fatal Car Driver Is Male Under 20

A composite picture of the man with less than three months' experience at the wheel, driving in a residential district, over a good road with a dry surface.

### Girl Crosses Country As Hitch-Hiker

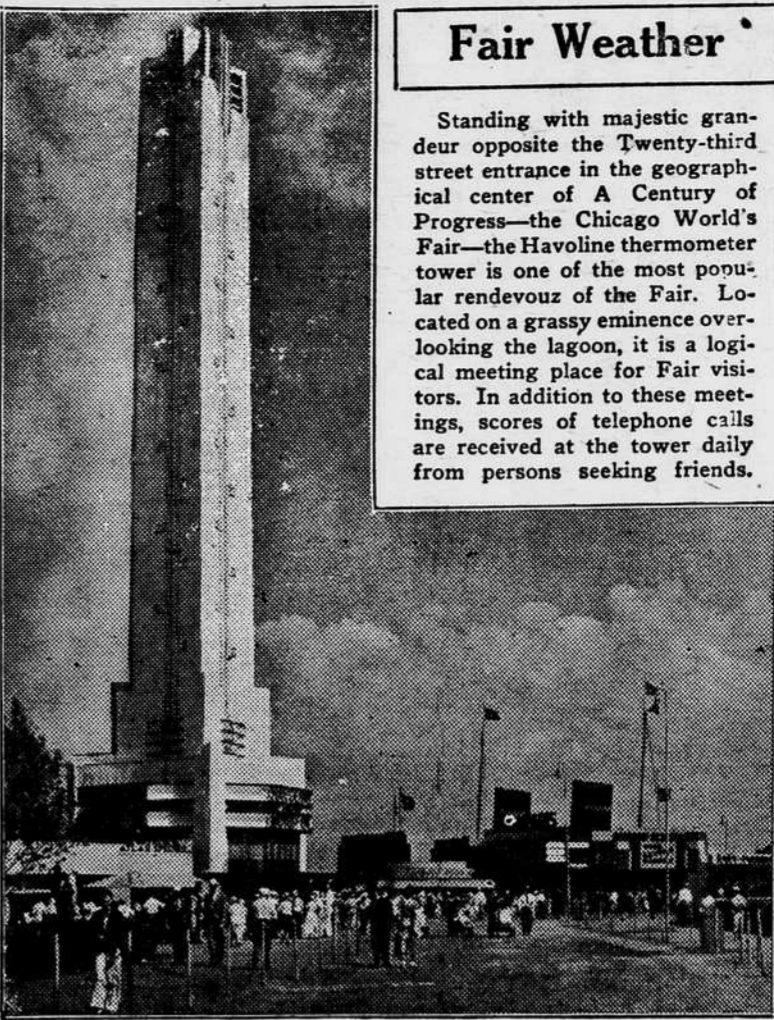
