Texas Wife Draws Code For Women

Says Woman Must Be Taken Out For Dinner and Others Dry the Dishes.

Beaumont, Texas—Hearing nothing about a 40-hour week for housewives, a home maker of Nederland Tex., has proposed a code of her own.

Received by B. B. Johnson, county judge in a letter which suggested its consideration by President Roosevelt and modestly signed "Mrs. L. T. P." the code follows:

Every housewife shall be taken out to dinner at last once a week. Husband or some other member of the family shall dry all the supper dishes.

Every housewife is entitled to a minimum of two movies weekly.

Husband shall help children with at least half of the home work.

Every housewife is entitled to ten per cent of family pay check for personal expenditures on self for clothes cosmetics, etc.

Every housewife (except where sickness or other emergency exists) is entitled to sleep late at least two mornings weekly.

Every housewife is entitled to extra help for house cleaning.

Brewery Locates For Statesville

Statesville—Officials of the Old South Brewing company have announced the purchase of the Sterling Flour Mill company's plant here and their purpose at once to convert it into a brewery. The local flour plant has been inactive and in receivership for several years and the Old South Brewing company is making the deal through the receiver W. E. Webb of Statesville.

The work of dismantling the flour mill has begun. The building will be remodeled and brewing machinery installed at once, so that the manufacture of beer may start in January and shipping the product may begin by March 1, 1934.
