

Parasites Affect Dairy Calves

The early spring months are the vorst time of year for cattle lice, particularly on calves. according to R. H. Ruffner, head of the State College animal husbandry department.

Cattle infested with lice cannot be thrifty, he said, and they frequently lick and rub their skin until the hair comes off in great patches around the tail-head, neck, and withers.

The best treatment consists of washing the animal with a solution of one ounce of sodium fluoride to one gallon of water, Ruffner said.

The liquid should be applied over the entire body and worked in well with a brush around the back and sides and with a rag under the belly and neck and between the legs.

A clear day is best for the treatnent, so that the animals will dry off rapidly. After the liquid has been applied the animals should be rubbed until almost dry, then allowed to stand quietly.

All manure should be cleaned out of the bars and the walls and floor swept and disinfected thor-
