

Henry C. Miller Is Instantly Killed Monday

Henry C. Miller, 58, was almost instantly killed about 5:30 o'clock Monday morning four miles west of this city on highway 10 when his car collided head-on with one driven by Dan Yoder.

Mr. Miller, who owns a filling station near the scene of the accident, was taking his son-in-law, Bill Bame, part of the way to Winston-Salem after the latter had spent Sunday with him. Yoder lives near Newton, but works at a hosiery mill at High Point, and was on his way to the latter city. The two cars met on a stretch of road that is almost straight and the impact badly damaged both ma-

chines. Bame was thrown clear of the wreck and was apparently only slightly hurt. Mr. Miller was a Spanish-American war veteran and for years was a street car conductor in Salisbury. Lately he has conducted a filling station at Milford hills. He is survived by his wife and two daughters, Mrs. Bame and Mrs. James E. Becker, the later the wife of a Salisbury city letter carrier.

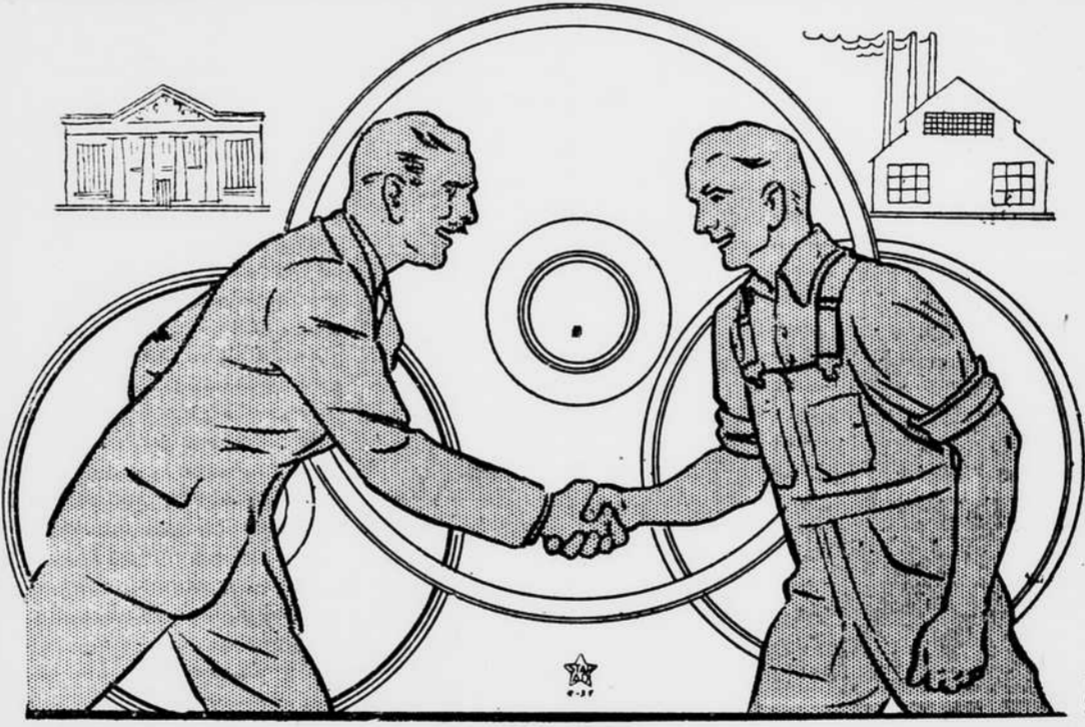
