Summer School Is Well Attended

The Summer School Sessions of 1936 had the largest attendance on record, despite some sweltering days and nights. 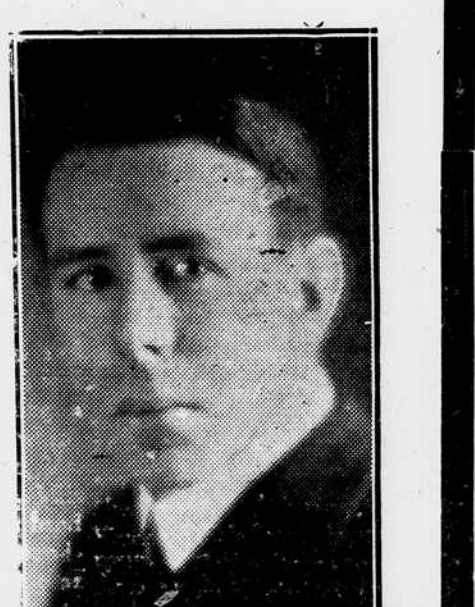
