

A.—Recent experiments with fertilizer placement for row crops indicate that it is best to put the fertilizer in narrow bands on each side of the seed. This helps to avoid too great a concentration of fertilizer salts near the roots of the plants especially during the seedling stage. The same results, however, may be obtained by placing the fertililer in the rows, if the application is made a week or ten days before planting and the fertilizer is mixed thoroughly with the soil. Broadcast applications are desirable when the rows are spaced close enough to require hand cultivation.

O.—Is there any sure way of preventing mite infestation of the hen house?

A.—There is no method of poultry management that will guarantee against the appearance of mites in the house. The best method is to observe strict sanitation and check at least once a week for the mites.
