WHIRLWIND SKATING STAR OF PICTURES FILMED ON ICE OF SUNNY CALIFORNIA

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
SONJA HENIE, damiing little ballering of the ice skating world, learned her art in Oslo, Norway, where her father, a figure skater of some note himself, began teaching her fifteen years ago. Winters in Europe, and next in the United States, brought her more and more fame.






