

PLENTY OF CLOTHING FOR THE TROOPS.—It will be seen from the report of the Quartermaster-General, sent to the Confederate Senate by the President in reply to certain resolutions recently adopted by that body, that officers of the army are allowed to purchase fabrics from the Government clothing bureaus, when the stock on hand is in excess of the wants of the private soldiers in the field. We take it that the stock of clothing material now on hand is super-abundant, as officers of the army may be daily seen at the merchant tailor establishments on Main street, selling at an advance of from one to two hundred per cent. the cloth obtained by them from the clothing bureau.
