PITTSBURG, June 23—Night—A thoroughly organized gang of counterfeiters, under the lead of Dr. Milton H. Frank, a practicing physician of Allegheny City, has been broken up and several of the members, including Frank, were arrested and \$20,000 in counterfeit money was also captured.

GOTHAM. TWEED. New York, June 23—Night—Tweed is still in Ludlow Street jail awaiting the procurement of three million dollars in the civil suit. His family and counsel visited him there to-day.

ELECTRICISMS. The rectifying establishment of Bevis, Frazer & Co., St. Louis, has been notified by orders from Washington for non-payment of \$44,000 taxes. A Hartford dispatch states that President Cummings, of the Wesleyan University, has tendered his resignation.

EUROPE. MORE FAILURES. THE CHINESE DIFFICULTY SETTLED. London, June 23—Night—The following failures have been announced: J. H. Randall & Son, No. 20 King William street, liabilities \$9,000,000; Wm. Marshall, of Manchester, liabilities \$5,000,000.

THE BLACK HILLS. VAST GOLD MINES. CHICAGO, June 23—Night—The special correspondent of the Inter-Ocean, with the scientific expedition in the Black Hills, at Camp Harney on French creek, sends the following telegram via Fort Laramie, dated June 16: Gold in large quantities and of good quality has been discovered in Castor's Gulch, French Creek and along this stream for a distance of upwards of seven miles towards its source or Gulch mines. There are scattered along French Creek four different mining parties, numbering twenty-five men, who have taken up claims on all of which good color has been obtained.

THE CHINESE DIFFICULTY SETTLED. London, June 23—Night—The King of Burmah has given a satisfactory explanation of his course of action to Sir Douglas Forsyth, the British Envoy. War is now considered impossible. Advice from China say that the disorder in Chin Kiang was caused by the arrest of two native soldiers for insulting the American Consul and his wife, and is now dying out, China having partially satisfied the demands for reparation.

THE CHINESE DIFFICULTY SETTLED. London, June 23—Night—The King of Burmah has granted to Great Britain the right to send forces through his dominions to western China, if requisite for future expedition. BRAZIL, June 23—Night—The German Government is preparing a Parliamentary measure prohibiting public religious processions. This is aimed at the Catholics. LONDON, June 23—Night—Wilson & Armstrong, No. 69 Aldermanburg at, have failed. Their liabilities are one million dollars.

SPOTTED TAIL. PREPARATIONS FOR A GIGANTIC WAR. OMAHA, June 23—Night—Advice from Spotted Tail's Agency state that three large war parties left that vicinity on the 17th inst., one of each for the Ponca or Pawnee and Shaoshone reservations. It is thought among posted men that a gigantic Indian war is about to be inaugurated. Information has been sent to the Indian Agents.

CALIFORNIA. SAN FRANCISCO, June 23.—The Peoples' Independent State Convention, after adopting long series of resolutions against monopolies, placed four gentlemen in nomination. Without coming to a vote they adjourned to to-morrow. The Peoples' Independent Convention nominated Gen. Bidwell, of Butte county, for Governor, and Lieut. and Acting Governor Pacheco for Lieut. Governor.
