We found that the people of that county are thoroughly aroused and we have great hopes that yesterday they reversed the decision of last year. Col. W. Foster French, was and had been for some days actively engaged in the canvass. At St. Paul, Howellville, Lumberbridge and other points, his voice had been heard in behalf of the white men, and his efforts will have an important bearing upon the result. We sincerely trust that Robeson has again allied herself with the white man's party.
