LOUISIANA'S last orange crop amounted to 16,250,000, and realized a net profit of \$810,000. The custom there is to sell the fruit on the trees at ten dollars a thousand, and let the shipper do the picking.

Wm. Gov. Chamberlain, of South Carolina, was absent from the state, the negro lieutenant governor Graves, commuted the death sentence of Joseph Gibbs to imprisonment for twenty years. Chamberlain holds that this action is null and void, and asks Judge Reed of the Charleston circuit to enforce the sentence of his court.
