Legal Tenders—No Successor to Deiano as Yet.

Washington, Sept. 28.—Three hundred and four thousand five hundred and eighty-four dollars of legal tenders have been retired, being 80 per cent. of the National Bank notes issued during the first part of the month.

NEW YORK

New York, Sept. 28.—Ned O' Baldwin, the Irish Giant, was shot twice by his partner in a liquor store. The wound is supposed to be mortal.
