WHILE three emperors are striving, according to the Official Gazette of Russia, to settle the troubles of Herzegovina, the insurgents are effectually shaping the basis of a settlement by their victories. It is as true now as when the Greek rebellion was the prominent feature of the Eastern Question, that "In native swords and native ranks the only hope of courage dwells."

The Jackson Times, the leading Republican organ in Mississippi, says: From the character of those who have controlled the primary caucuses of the party, and thence the leadership and policy and destiny of the Republican organization, defeat was only a question of time. It has come at last; and though by means we do not approve, yet it has overtaken us, and the party is at the bottom of the hill."

WAR says the Washington Capitol is not half so dangerous to human life as the most of us suppose. Fifteen thousand eight hundred and seventy-five survivors of the little army that did our fighting in 1812 are still drawing pensions. Were the Pension Bureau transferred to where it really belongs—the Surgeon General—and thereby made what it was intended to be, and not a foul political machine, the mortality among that fifteen thousand and eight hundred would be fearful, and a like death list would follow the other armies.

On top of the indictments of the President's friends at St. Louis, and the possible impeachment of himself as a party to the whiskey frauds, here we have Mr. Lane, the newly elected Congressman from Oregon, collecting materials for what is claimed will be a startling exposure to be made at the approaching session of the convention of affairs in Alaska under the management of the Alaska Commercial Company and the military authorities which there take the place of a Territorial government. THERE is no gentler organ in the country than the Boston Journal. It does not like the idea of a third term, yet see how tenderly it says it. Speaking of the President's recent speech, it remarks: The battle between the two currencies may indeed be yet more severe and protracted than General Grant supposes, but it is a material fact to find him, with his proverbial tenacity, still on the right side. His concluding expression of belief that the Republicans will control this government for at least four years longer, is essentially unobjectionable, while the modus of the expression is wholly at variance with any indulgence in the third term mania.

The Third Term campaign seems to have fairly opened. A Washington letter of Sunday last says: "A new Sunday paper has just been started here in the interest of the Third Term, and it is understood that yesterday an order was issued giving it to the government advertising. One of the other Sunday papers has to-day a lengthy article taking the ground that the Republican party is in the same condition that it was eight and four years ago, that it needs to be saved, and can only win a victory on the personal merits of its candidate for President. No other man but Grant, it is stated, will fill the bill." The following is stated as a fact: "Governor Hayes, after his campaign was over in Ohio, stated in the executive mansion in Harrisburg, while a guest of Governor Hartranft, that the educational question had given the Republicans the victory in the Buckeye State. It was Mr. Grant who made that question a Republican issue in a speech delivered a few weeks previous to the Ohio election."
