

These goods are particularly attractive and should be seen by every one who feels an interest in the resources and manufactures of North Carolina.

One of the most attractive features of the display is a set of hand painted china, the work of Miss Isabel Williams, of Fayetteville, N. C. The painting is done in a most artistic manner and does great credit to the talent of the lady: Four paintings by the same young lady are shown. The display of marls, guanos, etc.,

is very fine and complete. The display of wheat, corn and other grains is especially fine. The samples shown are equal to those grown anywhere. Grass seed, peanuts, rice and all kinds of grain in the sheaf are shown. There are several fine specimens of jute from which cotton bagging is made. The display of sugar and sorghum is highly creditable.

Of the woods shown there are 112 specimens. 
