GENERAL SOUTHERN NEWS.

LEXINGTON, Ky., Feb. 24.—Rev. Henry Maher, a Baptist preacher of Powell's Valley, committed suicide at his home.

FRANKFORT, Feb. 21.—The death of Judge Grace cast a gloom over both houses of the legislature yesterday.

NEW ORLEANS, Feb. 20.—The Whitney presidential campaign managers for the states of Mississippi, Arkansas, Louisiana and Alabama opened headquarters yesterday at the Greenwood hotel.

RICHMOND, Feb. 22.—The senate committee on courts of justice, by a vote of 9 to 4, has reported favorably the Maupin anti-gambling act.

LOUISVILLE, Feb. 23.—News has reached here of a double murder at Harlan Court House, Ky., in which Milford and Felix Fee were instantly killed.

SOMERSET, Ky., Feb. 18.—Last Saturday night a mob of fifty men compelled the jailor at Monticello, Wayne county, twenty-five miles from here, to surrender his keys.

FRANKFORT, Ky., Feb. 21.—The strained relations between Governor Bradley and Congress-man Hunter, the Republican nominee for senator against Blackburn, have reached a crisis since the publication in Louisville of an article charging Governor Bradley with the responsibility of Hunter not being elected.

HUNTINGTON, W. Va., Feb. 19.—Judge W. P. Thompson, who was treasurer of this state for eight years, and who was the first judge of the criminal court in this county, has been making extensive preparations for his death.

THE MYSTERY OF A MINE.

Skeletons of Four Men Who Disappeared Many Years Ago Discovered.

COLLIERS, W. Va., Feb. 24.—People are much excited in this vicinity over a recent find. David Snyder has explored an old coal mine a mile east of here, which has not been worked since the '60's.

Nov. 7—I am now alone with the dead. I had to kill Ewing in self defense. I have just eaten my other boot leg.

TURKISH METHODS IN FLORIDA.

Brutal Treatment of Men Unjustly Confined in a Convict Camp.

OCALA, Feb. 20.—After ten days of torture at a convict camp eleven young men were yesterday released on writs of habeas corpus issued by Circuit Judge Hocker.

Two weeks ago the party reached Ocala. They were well dressed, and said they were walking to see the country better and to hunt and fish at will.

At the ranch they were barbarously treated. They were chained to negroes and given impossible tasks. Every night, upon reporting the tasks unperformed, they were stripped, tied across logs and whipped with rawhides till the blood gushed.
