Senator Warner Miller, known more familiarly as "Wood-Pulp Miller," of Herkimer, New York, was born in Oswego county, that State August, 12th, 1838, and is therefore in his forty-sixth year. He graduated at Union College in 1860, and then became a teacher, but when the war broke out, in 1861, he enlisted as a private in the Fifth New York Cavalry. He served with conspicuous bravery in the Shenandoah Valley being promoted to Sergeant-Major and Lieutenant. At the battle of Winchester he was taken a prisoner, but was finally "exchanged" after the close of the rebellion. Mr. Miller engaged in farming and became the owner of extensive paper mills in which enterprise he still engaged. He was elected delegate to the National Republican Convention in Philadelphia, in 1872, and in 1874 was elected to the New York Legislature, serving two terms.
