Quoting a large number of tobacco grow-
ers met in Raleigh Wednesday of last
week and discussed the situation of
raising tobacco, and the low prices
at which it is selling. Many opinions
were expressed in regard to to-
bacco combines, and a leaf tobacco trust
was suggested but no action was taken
on that matter. It was decided to hold
a convention in Raleigh on the 17th of
January. In the meantime it was de-
cided that on the first Monday in Jan-
uary county conventions be held in all the
tobacco counties to appoint delegates to
the State convention.

A week ago the Manufacturers' Record
published an advertisement of a Western
convention, rated at \$500,000
to \$1,000,000 capital, asking for informa-
tion as to desirable locations in the South
for building a cotton mill, and in the
same issue an advertisement from another
concern seeking a location to build a
large brewery, the capital for which has

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE.

President McKinley sent his annual
message to Congress last week. The
message began with a reference to the
death of Vice-President Hobart.

The following is a summary of the mes-
sage:

On the threshold of our deliberations
you are called on to mourn with your
fellow countrymen the death of Vice
President Garret A. Hobart. His great
soul has entered into rest and eternal
peace. His private life was pure and
elevating his public career distinguished
by stainless integrity.

The condition of the entire country is
one of unusual prosperity and good will
among the people. We have relations
of friendship with every government in
the world. Our foreign commerce has
greatly increased in volume and the value
of the imports and exports is the largest
ever known in a single year. The Pres-
ident recommends that additional power
be given the Secretary of the Treasury to
sell United States bonds, and to em-
ploy other means necessary to maintain
the purity of gold and silver.

In regard to trusts the President says
that such combinations are justly provok-
ing public discussion and should claim
the early attention of Congress.

The President extensively reviews our
relations with foreign governments.

Our interests in China are not neglec-
ted, and trade with that country seems
to be growing.

Our relations with Germany are stated
as being cordial, but that great empire
seems reluctant to admit the excellence
of our food products.

This government has maintained an
attitude of neutrality between Great Brit-
ain and the Boers. Had circumstance
warranted our good offices would gladly
have been exercised as a consulting officer at Raleigh.
