### AN ORDINANCE.

An Ordinance prescribing rates and regulations for the Water Works for the Town of Weldon, N. C. As established by the commissioners of the Town of Weldon, N. C. as follows to-wit:

The water rates shall be as follows:

Barber shop, 1st chair	3.00

Each additional chair	1.00
Drug store, 1 space	5.00
Shooting Establishment	15.00
Slaughter house, 1 space	5.00
Restaurant, 1 space	5.00
Office, 1 space	5.00

Wash hand basin, public	6.00
Steam engine, per horse power, 10 hours per day	3.00

Water by meter measurements per 1,000 gallons	.30

The several departments of the town shall pay for all water consumed in the respective departments at meter rates where meters have been placed and if no meters have been placed in any such department the quantity of water consumed by any such department shall be estimated by said superintendent and the charges therefor shall be in accordance with said meter rates. The accounts of all such departments for water so consumed shall be carried on the books of said superintendent or Town Clerk as all other accounts are now kept.

Consumers of water outside of the corporate limits of the Town of Weldon, N. C., using water supplied by said town shall immediately install meters at their own expense and shall pay for said water at such rate as may be prescribed by the Water Committee provided that minimum rate shall not be less than regular meter rate.

By order of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Weldon, N. C. This ordinance effective July 1, 1922.


