COLORADO SILVER MINES

The wonderful Discoveries at Leadville.

LEADVILLE, Colo., Dec. 11.—New discoveries of rich silver deposits continue in the vicinity of Leadville. Among the latest and most remarkable one made by Lieutenant-Governor Tabor last Saturday morning of a carboniferous vein, from which \$200 were taken in one day. The discovery has been made also of a vein which is post on Ten Mile Creek, a distance of over seventeen feet unexplored.

Upon examination of the Denver & Rio Grande R.R. Company's books for November it appears that over 2,000,000 pounds of base bullion were transported from Leadville by railroads in November, and up to twice that quantity of high grade silver ore. The shipments from Colorado prongs alone in November of base silver bullion were 1,025,000 pounds. It is evident that the production of silver in the Leadville mines will very largely exceed any estimates hitherto published.

Judge Blodgett and the Chicago Bar. CINCINNATI, Dec. 11.—A meeting of the members of the Chicago Bar Association was held yesterday afternoon to take action in view of the determined effort being made to secure impeachment proceedings against Judge Blodgett, of the United States District Court. An address was adopted, and was signed by Hon. Wirt D. Dexter, Hon. Charles B. Lawrence, Hon. E. C. Larner and 520 others, including some of the eminent barristers in the city. It is addressed to Representative Harrison and other representatives in Congress and was forwarded last evening.

Steamboat Interests Before Congress

NEW YORK, Dec. 11.—A convention of steamboat men was held to-day to take such action as might be considered necessary to appeal to Congress to have steamship interests of the burdens of taxation upon commerce and industry against its progress. The proceedings of the meeting were not made public.

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 11.—J. C. Flood, John Mackay, et al., pleaded the statute of limitations to-day in the suits brought by Bark et al., stockholders in the Virginia Mines, for accounting for \$35,000,000.

The Russian War Vessels.

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 11.—There has been considerable activity displayed at Cramp's ship-yard during the past few days in preparing the Russian vessels for sea. It is understood that two of them will sail in a few days.

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 11.—Ex-Governor Andrew G. Curtin has served formal notice of contest on Seth H. Yocum (Republican and National) for a seat in the next Congress.
