## How Gen. Shields was Cured.

The late Gen Shields, at the battle of Cerro Gordo, in Mexico, was severely wounded while leading his men, but he refused to quit the field. He sdvanced to the charge, when he was struck in the chest by a copper grapeshot that passed through his lungs He fell into the arms of Oglesby, at present United States Senator from lilinois, and was carried from the battlefield to all appearances lifeless. Obituary notices appeared afterward in nearly all the papers of the country, so convinced were the brother officers of the impossibility of his surviving lay at the brink of death in the neighbo:hood of the battlefield, and his cure seems little short of a mirac'e. The army surgeons had given him over for death, when a Mexican doctor said he would live if he would let him remove the cosgulated blood from the wound. Shields, as a kill or cure remedy, told him to try, and a fine silk haudkerchief was worked in and finally drawn through the would, removing the extravasant blood, when daylight could be seen through the hote. He lived to be a hale and hearty man, free from disease or any inc. nve nience from the wound, which was considered at that time mortal.
