

We are poisoned in other ways than in our food. Mr Angell found that enough arsenic was imported into this country every year to hill six times the entire population of the world. It is used in all paper, lamp-shades, wrapping papers for coafectionery, ladies' dress good-, veils, socks, gloves, children's toys, etc. A child in Troy, New York, died a few days ago by taking arsenic from a veil thrown over it to keep off the flue. Lead poisoning from using vessels of lead is another dauger we are aimost a ways running. It is especially daugerous, because lead is cumutative poison; not instantaneous, but taking years to affect a person, when it finally brings on paralysis or meningetis Notwithstanding all these admitted facts, only two States in the Union have taken any action in the matter-Wisconsin, which published and circulated throughout the State 50,000 p mphlets giving these various poisons used in adultering food articles and the antidotes for them, and Massachusetts, which passed a very severe law against these adulterations and succeeded in locking up in the peniten. tiary a number of these public poisoners. Baths in the School-Room A mission school in Philadelphia has in its basement a large bathing and awimming department: There are four great tubs , in which the dirty little children are free to cleanse them= selves and to take aquatic exercise under prescribed regulations. Each tub accommodates nearly two dozen children at a time. The surrounding floors and walls are of brick and concrete, so that no restriction is put on splashing. A man with a small whip in his hand stands by during bathing hours ready to castigate any of the young persons who are unruly or violent. To their credit it must be said that he is seldom compelled to use it. The girls bathe and swim on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays and the boys on the other days of the week. The rule is that no child shall be allowed to exter the baths more than twice a day.
