The government, deeming it undesirable that any subject should possess wealth so colossal, introduced a bill limiting entail to living persors and 21 years afterward. This is not much greater than the power of entail in New York, and almost identical with that in Massachusetts. Many estates in and around New York-the Leffarts, Rhinelander, for exampleare entailed. In Eng and hundreds of great properties are completely unentailed, and it is purely the custom, not the law, of the country which will cause them to be transmitted to the eldest son. Men who are very liberal in politics favor the custom, because they think that it keeps up the position of a family, and that were an estate divided up in the next generation none would be better for such division. It is not generally understood here that the law in E gland permits a man to leave his property precisely as he pleases, and that a duke can leave all to his footman. The great estates, for instanc, of the Duke of Hamilton,
