

"The Decline of Wilmington."

We are reminded of one fact which we neglected to state in our editorial article in Tuesday's issue of the REVIEW, relative to the alleged "decline of Wilmington," which will be found of interest in connection with this subject. As was stated by us in that article the increase of cotton from last September 1st to January 31st, of this year, was 15,239 bales, fully 15 per cent over last year. In addition to this there would have been a further increase of about :20,000 bales but for the fact that freight room could not be had here. We know of one firm alone who had expressed a decided preference for this port and who did ship largely here, who would have given Wilmington at least 15,000 bales






