TO RUN BY ELECTRICITY.

A New Company's Scheme to Propel Elevated Trains.

The Electric Railway Company of the United States, with a capital of \$2,000,000, has filed articles of incorporation with the Secretary of State.

The first practical work to be undertaken by the new company will be to place an electric engine in operation on the elevated railway.
