The Baltimore Manufacturers' Record announces that twenty-five steamships are due to arrive at that port prior to September with 45,000 tons of iron ore from Mediterranean ports. It is estimated that the total quantity to arrive during the period named will equal 90,000 tons. Since Januray 1 the total receipts at Baltimore have been 93,000 tons, against 50,000 tons in a like portion of 1882. The bulk of this ore goes by rail to the Pennsylvania steel mills. To move the 90,000 or 100,000 tons to arrive within sixty days about 10,000 cars will be required. Freights from the Mediterranean to this side are now low.

The locomotive which carried off the highest honors at the Chicago Exposition is No. 372, of the Philadelphia & Reading Railway. 


