Many inquiries are made about the electoral vote, under the new apportionment. We publish it for public information:

Table of Electoral Votes for various states. Total 401. The successful Presidential candidate must get at least 201 votes. The following provisions of the Constitution, condensed by Mr. James M. Swank, are timely, and may be important:

"If any candidate for the Presidency fails to receive a majority of the whole number of electoral votes, then from the persons having the highest numbers, not exceeding three, on the list of those voted for as President, the House of Representatives shall choose immediately, by ballot, the President. But in choosing the President the votes shall be taken by States having one vote; a quorum for this purpose shall consist of a member or members from two-thirds of the States, and a majority of all the States shall be necessary to a choice."
